BREMBO'S COMMITMENT

SOSTENIAMOCI 2 PROJECT, PROMOTING THE SOCIAL INTEGRATION OF YOUNG MIGRANTS (ITALY)

SOSTeniamoci is a project launched in 2016 by the CESVI Foundation in collaboration with Brembo and the Children and Family Support Service in Bergamo which aims to work alongside unaccompanied foreign minors and help them achieve their life-long goals and move towards social integration and economic independence. The second two-year project has also come to an end.



TARGET

- Promote the reception and integration of 19 unaccompanied foreign minors and young adults.
- Strengthen individual skills and respect every participant's aspirations.
- Give them the opportunity to achieve their life-long goals in Italy.



ACTIONS

- Teaching of the Italian language and courses in civic education to help them integrate in Italy.
- Participation in training courses selected to match the abilities and aspirations of each participant via skills assessment.
- Organization of apprenticeships and tutoring programs to find employment.



RESULTS

- 15 young migrants who have taken part in the project have entered the job market, 2 in the same company in which they served their apprenticeships.
- 4 young migrants have benefited from the individual tutoring program to find employment.
